COUNTRY SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS FOR DOCUMENTS ASSESSMENT

LISBON CONVENTION COUNTRIES

For students with a degree issued by a <u>Country</u> which has signed the <u>Lisbon Recognition</u> <u>Convention</u> it is mandatory to upload only the degree, along with CIMEA Statement of Verification, unless an online verification tool or the e-Apostille are available.

Politecnico di Milano will check the Statement of Correspondence on CIMEA ARDI database (https://ardi.cimea.it/en) for each of the above-mentioned degrees, and reserves the right to request further documentation, such as diploma supplement or declaration of value, if necessary.

CHINA

All the Chinese degrees can be verified online from the CSSD (China Credentials Verification) website: https://www.chsi.com.cn/en/.

Apart from the declaration of value, or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students with a Chinese degree must upload the "Online Verification Report of Higher Education Degree Certificate", along with the actual degree.

INDIA

All the Indian degrees can be verified online with the e-Apostille. Apart from the declaration of value, or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students with an Indian degree must upload their degree with the e-Apostille containing the QR code necessary for the verification.

IRAN

All the Iranian degrees can be verified online from the Saorg (Student Affairs Organization) website: https://portal.saorg.ir/inquiry. Apart from the declaration of value, or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students with an Iranian degree must upload the documents related to the degree itself, containing the QR code necessary for the verification.

Students graduated from Azad University cannot have their degree verified from the Saorg website, and must therefore upload both CIMEA Statement of Verification and Statement of Comparability.

Due to the frequent instability of the Saorg (Student Affairs Organization) website, students graduated from all Iranian universities, at any time <u>may be asked to submit their degree accompanied by translation and CIMEA Statement of Verification</u>.

RUSSIAN FEDERATION

Unfortunately, the e-Apostille on Russian documents cannot be verified with the internet providers currently in use.

Also, the government database <u>FRDO</u> is currently not accessible from Italy.

For these reasons, unless a digital verification method is offered by the institution issuing the degree, this must be accompanied by CIMEA Statement of Verification.

TURKEY

Unless a degree can be verified online on the higher institution of graduation's website, the students must ask the university to issue the degree on the Government website https://www.turkiye.gov.tr/belge-dogrulama. It is therefore necessary to upload a copy of the title containing the barcode number or gr code for the online verification.

PAKISTAN

All the Pakistani degrees can be verified online from the Higher Education Commission (HEC) website.

Apart from the declaration of value or CIMEA Statement of Comparability, students must upload both their degree with the HEC stamp affixed to it, as well as their passport (this must be uploaded in "My Data" section of the OnLine Services).
